Health Center Adds Physician to Staff

Mashpee – Cape Cod Free Clinic & Community Health Center has welcomed a new physician to its staff. Anna Hallemeier, M.D., board certified in internal medicine and pediatrics, is seeing patients at the Health Center's office in Mashpee.

After receiving an undergraduate degree in anthropology from Harvard University, Dr. Hallemeier obtained her medical degree from Yale School of Medicine. She completed her residency in medicine and pediatrics at Yale New Haven Hospital, which is the primary teaching hospital for Yale School of Medicine. Before joining the Health Center's clinical team, she was on the internal medicine faculty at Yale.

At the Health Center, Dr. Hallemeier sees adult and pediatric patients and is especially interested in working with teens. "It's about more than their medical care," she says. "The behavioral choices they make in their teenage years will affect the rest of their lives. I enjoy working with them so they understand the consequences of their decisions."

Her search for a practice opportunity took her up and down the eastern seaboard. "I was so taken with the energy and good feeling of the staff at the Health Center," she says. That, as well as the prospect of living on Cape Cod convinced her and her husband that this was the right position and the right place to raise a family. They have a three-year old daughter and one-year old son.
