Dr. Taylor Awarded Recertification in Internal Medicine

Mashpee – Lisa M. Taylor, MD, Medical Director at Community Health Center of Cape Cod has been awarded recertification in Internal Medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM).

The ABIM is a non-profit, independent evaluation organization that sets the standards and certifies the knowledge, skills and attitudes of physicians who practice in Internal Medicine and its subspecialties. For more than 70 years, certification by the ABIM has stood for the highest standard in internal medicine and its 18 subspecialties and has meant that internists have demonstrated that they have the clinical judgment, skills and attitudes essential for the delivery of excellent patient care. Recertification is required every 10 years.

Dr. Taylor is a graduate of the Robert Wood Johnson Medical School in Piscataway, NJ. She completed her residency at Christiana Hospital in Wilmington, DE, where she was chief resident.

Dr. Taylor was a physician volunteer at the Health Center, prior to her appointment as Medical Director in 2003. She oversees the delivery of medical care at the Health Center and also sees patients for their primary care needs. In 2006 she was named Community Clinician of the Year by the Barnstable District Medical Society of the Massachusetts Medical Society.
