Obama Campaign Manager Speaks in Benefit for Community Health Center of Cape Cod

Falmouth –David Plouffe, campaign manager for Barack Obama’s 2008 presidential campaign, will offer an insider’s perspective at a benefit event for Community Health Center of Cape Cod. The event will take place on Thursday, August 6 at 6:30 PM at the Coonamessett Inn in Falmouth.

Mr. Plouffe served as chief campaign manager for the historic presidential bid. He was described by The Chicago Tribune as “the mastermind behind a winning strategy” and by Mr. Obama himself as “the unsung hero of this campaign”. In 2006 he was a senior advisor for Deval Patrick’s successful campaign for Governor of Massachusetts and has signed on to Patrick’s 2010 re-election bid.

General admission tickets are \$75. Benefactors at the \$1,000 level receive four tickets, a private reception with Mr. Plouffe prior to the program, and a signed copy of his upcoming book. Patrons at the \$500 level receive two tickets and the private reception. All proceeds of the event will benefit Community Health Center of Cape Cod.
