Program to Showcase Health Services for Women

Mashpee – October is Breast Cancer and Domestic Violence Awareness Month. To educate area women about the health services and social supports that are available in the region, Community Health Center of Cape Cod will present “An Evening of Women’s Wellness” on Tuesday, October 21. The program will take place from 4:30 to 7:00 pm at the Health Center at 107 Commercial Street in Mashpee.

The program will offer information about free mammography and PAP tests that are available for uninsured and underinsured women. Participants will be able to sign up for these services, apply for MassHealth and Commonwealth Care, talk with the Health Center’s women’s health services staff, and meet representatives of other health providers and community-based organizations. Other participating organizations include: Independence House, Cape Cod Center for Women, Haven for Healing, and the Breast Care Center of Falmouth Hospital.

According to Megan Luizzi, the Health Center’s Program Director of Falmouth Family Planning, “We hope the event will provide women in the community with an opportunity to obtain information and support regarding these important issues in a welcoming and supportive atmosphere”.
